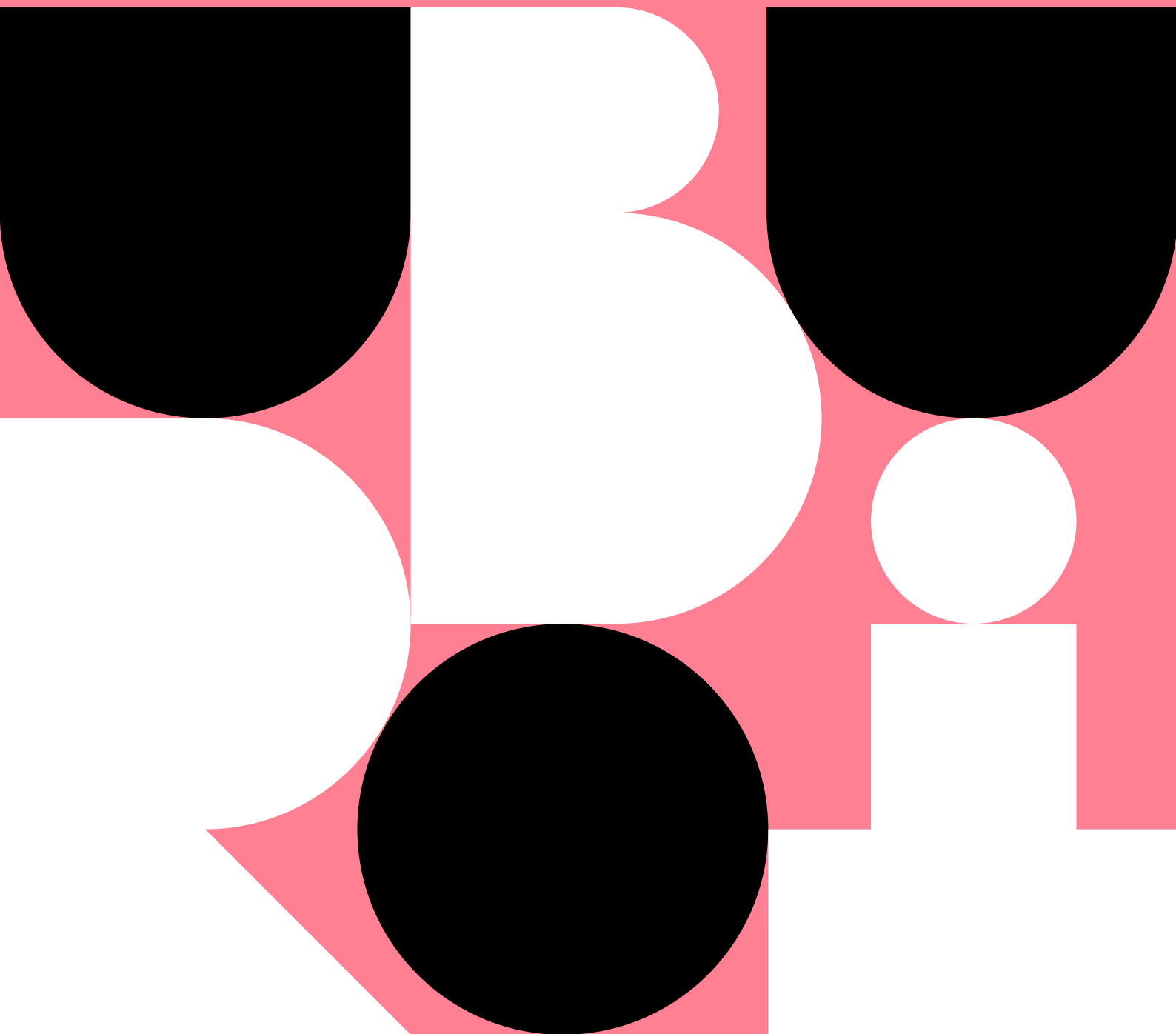

Ubu is a geometric type system in two versions, Ubu Block and Ubu Slab, each drawn in four individual styles that can also correspond with one another in interlocking layers.

In the 500 Fat weights, all characters touch each other, whereas in the 480 Solid and 480 Black weights they are separated by hairline spaces and in their inverse, 480 White, by hairline rules.

The typeface is named after Ubu Roi, a dramatic production written by Alfred Jarry in 1896.

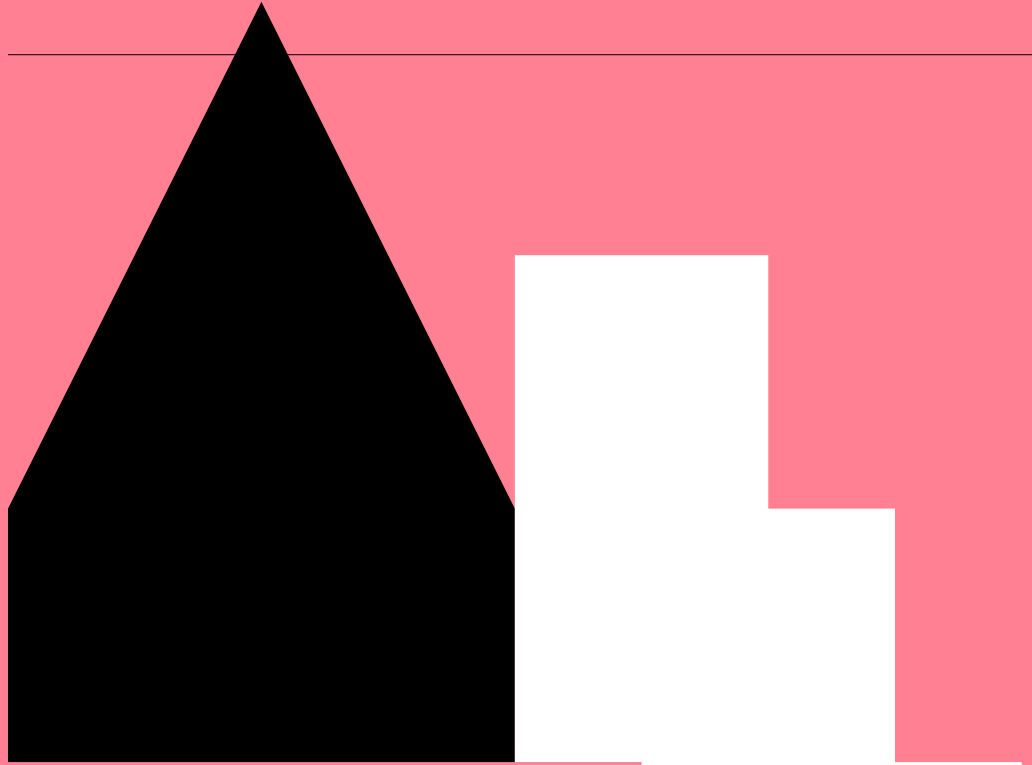
